

12. Langley

4 miles [shorter route 2 $\frac{1}{3}$ miles]

Walk from Langley Station along the canal down quiet country lanes and past small copses. Views across ancient parkland to Langley Mansion.

Easy Access **** Mostly level walking on good paths. Steps to the canal and 2 stiles

Public Transport ** Pubs and shops in Langley town centre south of the railway station

Public Transport ***** Frequent trains from London and Slough. Local buses stop in Langley town centre

[1] From Langley station turn right onto Langley Park Road then, at the bridge, walk down the steps on your left and along the canal towpath. After 1/3 mile cross the canal on the bridge.

The Slough Arm of the canal was dug in 1882 to connect the brickfields of Slough and Langley with the mainline canal at Cowley.

[2] Continue straight ahead for 1/2 mile then at the T-Junction turn left and follow the path along the line of ancient trees then across the edge of George Green Field to a road.

For the shorter route turn right at the T-Junction, then turn right again after the second gate and follow the route from point 5.

[3] Turn right onto the road then turn immediately right again through the gates into George Green Field. Follow the path across the field. After passing through a kissing gate turn right and follow the path past Langley Mansion then past the Arboretum

[4] Where the path forks bear right and continue past the arboretum, a field, then a small wood on your right. Turn right just before the gate then follow this path along the edge of Langley Park for 1/2 mile till you reach a road.

[5] Follow this quiet country lane then, at the road junction continue straight ahead. When you reach the Main road turn right and walk the short distance back to the station.
