

1. Rickmansworth

1 ½ miles

A short walk from Rickmansworth town centre to the Aquadrome and back via St. Mary's church.

Easy Access ***** *Good paths, level walking, no stiles.*

Refreshments ***** *Several pubs and cafes in Rickmansworth. Café at the Aquadrome.*

Public Transport ***** *Trains from London, Amersham & Aylesbury. Several buses stop at the station.*

[1] From Rickmansworth station turn right, then cross under the railway bridge. Turn right when you reach the High Street and follow the road past Marks & Spencer, then follow the S-bend to the roundabout.

[2] Cross Riverside Drive on the zebra crossing and turn left. Turn right after the playground and cross the River Colne. At the lake turn right and follow the path around the lake for ½ mile keeping the shoreline immediately on your left.

[3] Just before you reach the river, turn right then left onto the canal towpath. Cross the River Chess on the new footbridge. Walk along the avenue of Poplars then cross Riverside Drive using the pedestrian crossing on your right.

[4] Cross the bridge then turn left onto the path beside the stream. Walk through the churchyard then follow the road past The Feathers pub. Turn left when you reach the High Street, then right onto Station Road to get back to the railway station.
