



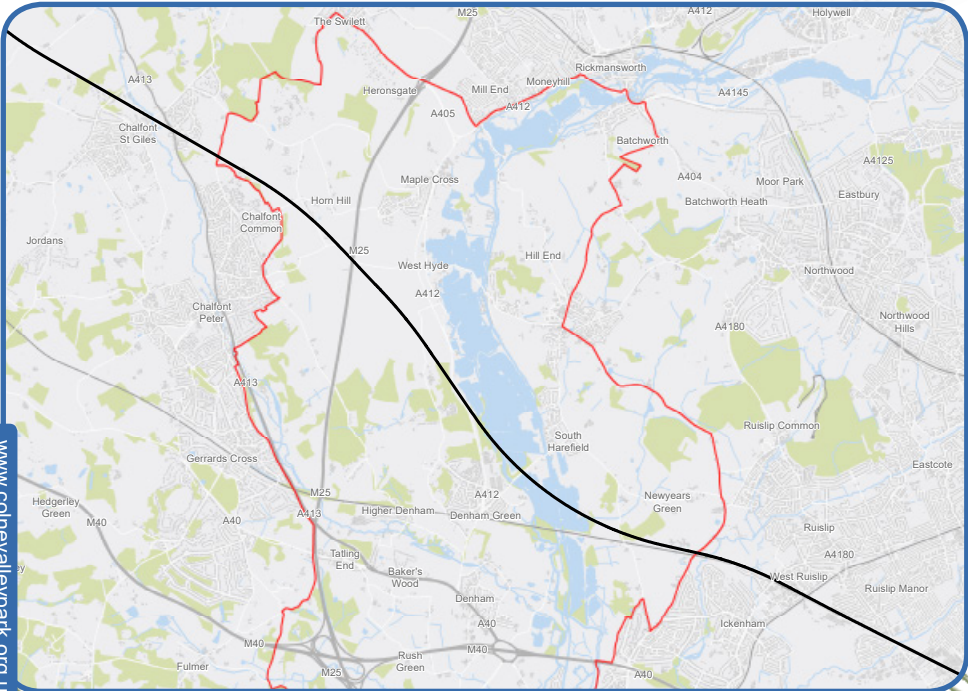

What is the Additional Mitigation Plan?

As a result of petitions submitted to the House of Commons, High Speed 2 Limited has been required to fund an Additional Mitigation Plan that will further reduce impacts on the Park. The intention is to propose projects that will go beyond the measures already committed to by HS2. The Additional Mitigation Plan will be finalised in summer 2017 and, once complete, HS2 will make available £3 million to support the delivery of the projects.
