THE COLNE VALLEY PARK AT A GLANCE

Where is the Colne Valley Park?

The Park is the first taste of countryside to the west of London. The Park runs from Rickmansworth in the north to Staines in the South, Uxbridge & Heathrow in the East to Slough and Chalfont in the west.

Some key facts

- 3 Million people live within 10 miles of the Park
- The Park contains over 60 lakes, over 200km of rivers and canals, over 270km of paths, 5 country parks, 7 Local Nature Reserves and 13 Sites of Special Scientific Interest

What are the objectives of the Park?

- To maintain and enhance the **landscape**
- To safeguard the **countryside**
- To conserve and enhance **biodiversity**
- To provide opportunities for countryside **recreation**
- To achieve a vibrant and sustainable **rural economy**
- To encourage **community participation**

What has the Park achieved? Some of the headline achievements since 1965 include:

- 8-10 fold return on every pound invested to deliver many exciting innovative projects
- Five country parks established
- 47km of footpaths and bridleways created (an average of 1km/year!)
- Local people give over 3,175 volunteer days each year, representing a value of £160,000.
