In 1982 a photographic survey record was made of the entire area of the Colne Valley Regional Park. This was achieved by visiting every map reference grid intersection, of the Landranger series Ordnance Survey map which occurred within the park, from the aspect of North, East, South and West. A total of 111 points (444 photographs). We are repeating this exercise in order to record the changing landscape over the 31 year period.
