


The Colne Valley Trail

Explore the Colne Valley Trail, a long distance walking route through the heart of the Colne Valley Regional Park.

How to follow the trail:

- 1 Start at the River Colne crossing and head west along Batchworth Lake, turning left towards the café.
- 2 From the café the path weaves its way west along the southern boundary of Bury Lake.
- 3 At the end of Bury Lake turn off and follow the Grand Union Canal to Springfield Lock.
- 4 At Springfield Lock the trail leaves the canal. Head up Springwell Lane and through open farmland to join the northern end of Summerhouse Lane, cross the road and continue down Jacks Lane.
- 5 Re-join the canal at Black Jack's Lock and continue to Moorhall Road.
- 6 Head under the canal bridge and up to Moorhall Road. Continue east into Denham Quarry Woodlands.
- 7 The trail continues alongside picturesque lakes and crosses the canal at the white bridge just north of Denham Deep Lock.
- 8 Continue along the canal, past Denham Country Park and through Uxbridge centre all the way to Iver Lane.
