

The Colne Valley Trail

- 9 Turn off at Old Mill Lane and around the edge of Little Britain Lake to Packet Boat Lane.
- 10 Break off and head south through woodland, just near the small car park.
- 11 Head adjacent to fishing lakes and turn off before Trout Lane. Cross the River Colne and turn over the railway bridge (near Iver Water Treatment Works).



- 12 Continue over Thorney Mill Road, into Thorney Country Park, under the M25 and along the main road before crossing the M4 at Old Slade Lane.
- 13 Follow the western edge of Old Slade Lake, across a minor road and past two more lakes before following the river through farmland to the trails end point at the Colnbrook By-Pass.

The Langley Branch

- 14 After point 8 you may wish to take the Langley branch of the trail heading east. If so, continuing along Iver Lane, branch off down Palmer's Moor Lane, cross the M25 and the Colne Brook to Coppins Lane.
- 15 Follow north up Bangors Road South, turn off along Love Green Lane.
- 16 Cross Swallow Street, go past the entrance to Swallow Street Woodland and along to Wood Lane.

- 17 Cross Wood Lane and continue to Bellswood Lane.
- 18 Cross Billet Lane and follow the track to Langley Park. Turn left and head adjacent to an orchard before joining up with Love Hill Lane, then continue south onto Trenches Lane.
- 19 A footpath then takes you off Trenches Lane and through open fields before running parallel to the Grand Union Canal.
- 20 Cross over both the Grand Union Canal and the railway bridge before reaching the trails end point on Alderbury Road West.
