Caring for the countryside on your doorstep

The Colne Valley Regional Park is the first taste of countryside to the west of London. It covers 43 square miles from Rickmansworth to Staines, Uxbridge to the Chalfonts. A mosaic of farmland, woodland and water, it's a living, working environment providing jobs and homes for many. It's a haven for wildlife.

Why is the park important?

45,000 people live in the park and 3 million live within 10 miles. More than 2 million visit each year. Given its size and how close it is to London, you can see how important the park is for those living nearby. It is where we exercise, walk the dog, take a Sunday stroll. It's home to our local farmers and food producers. It plays a big part in tourism – arriving at Heathrow it's the first view of English countryside. The park is a haven for plants and wildlife. There are 70 lakes, 200km of rivers and canals, 270 km of public rights of way, 100s of green spaces, 5 country parks, 20 nature reserves, 13 Sites of Special Scientific Interest and part of a Special Protection Area (of European importance for wildlife).

All this benefits everything from our health and wellbeing to our house prices.

How can you help?

Funds from corporate supporters enable us to work to raise yet more funds, provide information and opportunities for people to enjoy the park and make physical improvements for people and wildlife. Since the Park was first established 50 years ago, the following has been achieved:

- 5 country parks established
- 50km of new paths created
- Thousands of walks, talks, events and festivals organised
- £6-£10 of external funding is secured each year for every £1 invested in the Park
